Feeding Middlesex County's volunteer board members represent a cross-section of the local population from government, banking, education, commerce, agriculture and more. Yamille Chaves, Assistant Vice President of Provident, serves on the board as well the communications committee.

Feeding Middlesex County Chair, Jane Brady, concluded "Hunger is a year round struggle. Our new organization has the ability to raise public awareness and raise funds to help MCFOODS and the more than 100 members that fight food insecurity in Central New Jersey. Who wouldn't want to help a neighbor going through hard times?"
